WORK PLAN

- **Adoption of strategy** by the new structure of the nanosafety working grouping on risk
- **Issues e.g.**
 - Include modelling issues in Risk Assessment (Malaga meeting, November)
 - Include long-term Risk Assessment issues for materials in use
 - Implement regulatory strategies/road maps for Risk Assessment

- Preparing a workshop to take place at the EU-US in 2016, leading to a common framework.

US-EU - CoR

- Integrating and coordinating Risk Assessment across the EU and US – through phone meeting together with database/modelling CoR etc.
- WG5 lead regular phone meeting has taken place, within the risk CoR and with other CoRs.
- 2016-2017 - 4 major phone conferences:
 - Human risk (September 2016)
 - Environmental risk (November 2016)
 - Risk communication (January 2017)
 - Risk legal and regulatory connection (March 2017)

US-EU - CoR

- The Risk CoR chaired a 1 day workshop at the US-EU Cor meeting in Washington June 2016, with the main focus on risk and risk communication, involving stakeholders and social scientists.
- Preparing a workshop to take place at the EU-US in 2016, leading to a common framework.
